Division A: Adults - Grange members/Non-Grange member 14 years and above
(Adult Participants must be Grange members to qualify for National Grange Talent contest)

Division B: Juniors - Grange members/Non-Grange member 13 years and younger

Talent Contest Categories:

- a. Vocal
- b. Instrumental Music
- c. Variety Acts – to include dance, skit, reading, monologue

Criteria for Judging Talent:

- a. Stage presence
- b. Skill presentation
- c. Suitability of number
- d. Audience appeal

Talent Contest Rules:

1. Idaho State Grange Talent Contest will be held during State Session in October.
2. The maximum time is 6 minutes per entry. There is no minimum time.
3. Accompanist need not be a Grange member
4. Taped accompaniment for vocal acts must be instrumental only.
5. For instrumental acts, there is to be no taped sounds or other instruments in the taped accompaniment
6. If fewer than three entrants in any class, we may award one set of prizes for each division (Adult and Junior)
7. The “Best of Show” winner is eligible to perform at National Grange Convention’s Talent Show (not a competition) in November of this year.
8. Group entries may include non-members. At least half of participants must be Grange members to qualify for National Talent Contest.

AWARDS: The Idaho State Grange will present cash prizes of \$25, \$15 and \$10 for each category and in each division containing a minimum of 3 entries. If fewer than 3 entries, categories may be combined. Best of Show can perform at National Grange Talent Show in November.
