We lost two members this last quarter, so our membership is shrinking. To help cut down on expenses, we have unplugged the freezer to lower the hall's SDG&E bill.

To try to attract more renters, a Hall Rental Brochure has been created to advertise our hall. These brochures have been placed at the Fallbrook Chamber of Commerce. All local members should have some of them on hand to give out. Please come to our meeting or contact me to get the brochures.

Rentals are our main income and we had only one renter this summer. The hall insurance bill is coming due the end of October and our bank account does not have enough to cover it right now, so we will need to hold a fundraiser or two.

Lucette and I held a yard sale at the grange last month. We collected \$50 in rental spaces.

We are thinking of having a pizza and wine tasting dinner fundraiser. Lucette and I will handle the pizza part if someone else will recruit wineries to provide the wine for the tasting. Or we can do two separate events.
