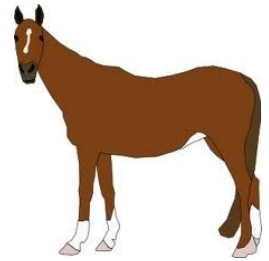
Over the last couple of weeks the two pygmy date palms flanking the front door of the grange hall have been dug up. Lucette has
