WASHINGTON-YAMHILL POMONA DISASTER FUND

This fund has been established for the emergency use of a Grange member or a Grange of this Pomona District following a catastrophic event such as fire, flood, or earthquake. The maximum amount of money issued will be five hundred dollars (\$500) per occurrence.

A Grange may use the money from this fund for purchasing materials to protect the hall or to rent another facility while its hall is being repaired. A member may request these funds for emergency needs, i.e., payment of rent, purchasing clothing, food, or medicine, etc.

A request for this money must be submitted by the Grange member, Grange, or other knowledgeable individual. The request shall be made to the Pomona. Following the request, the Pomona Grange Executive Committee shall be empowered to release the money from the Disaster Fund as they so see fit.

This fund shall receive fifteen percent (15%) of all money-raising events of this Pomona providing the money-raising event is not otherwise designated for a specific purpose.

The rules of this Disaster Fund require a Pomona Grange vote.
