

Friendship Star

For the Friendship Star block you will need:

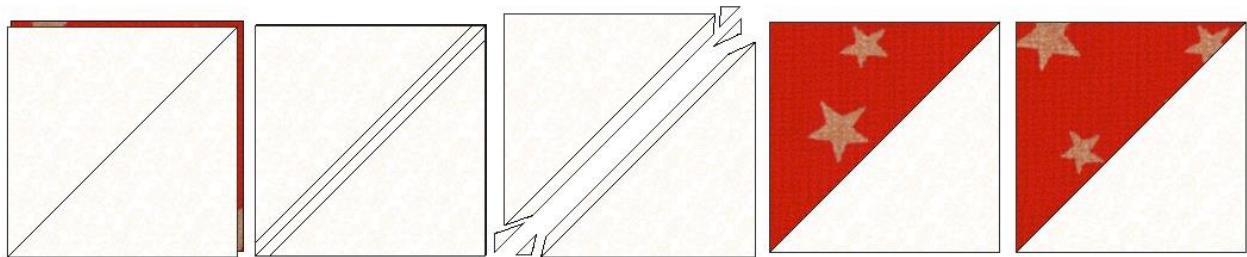
- Star color, red or blue, cut
 - two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares
 - one $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square.
- Background color, white or cream, cut
 - two $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares
 - four $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares.

Step 1

Half Square Triangles:

Place red and white $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch square right sides together. Carefully draw a line corner to corner, (diagonally) through the white $4 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. This will be a cutting line when you are finished. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ on either side of the drawn line.

Press your square to the dark, clip off the corners as shown and square your block to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square.



Step 2

Now you can assemble your block. Make two sets like this. Press seams to the left.



Make one set like this. Press seams to the right.



Now you can finish your block and it should look like this and measure 12 1/2 inches exactly!

Step 3

Sew rows together, seams will nest together.
