The Aloha Grange is available for rental on both a Short-Term and Long-Term Basis. Below are the **Short-Term Rental Rates** for non-Grange members. The Grange is heavily utilized, but there are times within the week/month that are available.

To check for Grange availability, go to the Aloha Grange #773 website and click the tab that says "Calendar" <http://www.grange.org/alohaor773/>. You will note that there are very few evenings available for renting the grange because the Grange has long been a venue for dancing. However, the Friday and Saturday evenings on the 5th weekend of the month are frequently available for rental, as are various morning and afternoons.

The **Short-Term Contract**, which delineates the process and responsibilities of both the Renter and Grange are also available under the tab that says "Rental".

Note: To ensure rental of the Grange facility, the Renter Must: (1) Complete Short-Term Rental Contract, (2) Deliver Payment of \$300 Security Deposit and the full amount of the rental fee (above), and (3) submit to the Grange a *Certificate of Insurance* as proof of coverage for general liability risks, including coverage for damages caused by the Renter in the amount of \$1,000,000. This *Certificate of Insurance* can be purchased through the Renter's Homeowner's Insurance policy and is fairly inexpensive. (See Short-Term Contract for more information.)
