## **Scholarship Application**

## **Eligibility**

- 1. The applicant must be applying to, accepted to, or attending a post-secondary institution. Qualifying institutions are two- and four-year colleges and universities, graduate or professional schools, community colleges, trade schools or vocational schools.
- 2. The applicant must be applying as a full-time student.
- 3. Applicant can be pursuing any major or field of study.
- 4. Award must be used in the upcoming academic year.
- 5. Applicants must be part of the local community.
- 6. Applicants that are active members of the Five Mile Prairie Grange 905 will have priority.

## **Scholarship Information**

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of up to \$500 each which will be paid directly to the institution.
- 2. The Five Mile Prairie Grange will determine the number of scholarships awarded.
- 3. Scholarships are a one-time award.

  - c. Official transcripts from high school and college (if applicable).

  - a. Scholastic achievements
  - b. Participation in extracurricular, community service and Grange activities
  - c. Character references
  - d. Essav
  - e. Completeness in filling out application form
