Sequim Prairie Grange #1108 was started in 1942 and met in the Macleay School, which the members bought from the Sequim School District in the early 1960's. There are approximately 210 members at this time. The Grange meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm for the business meeting. The 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month (with the exception of (June& August) the grange meets at 6:30 pm for a potluck dinner/social night.
